WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines Police Department, with the assistance of the Des Moines Independent Community School District, is filing a grant application through the Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) Office, 2010 COPS Secure Our Schools grant program, to request funding which would bring state-of-the-art security systems to Des Moines schools; and,

WHEREAS, this project is estimated to cost \$200,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, the grant will fund up to 50% of the total cost to implement the programs; and,

WHEREAS, the Des Moines School District has agreed to provide the rest of the funding with the Police Department responsible for the administration of the grant: and,

WHEREAS, the grant is for a two-year period;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the grant applications under the COPS Secure Our Schools program is hereby approved, with the Mayor authorized to sign the application on behalf of the City, with City Clerk to attest to the Mayor's signature, and the City Manager and his staff directed to take any and all steps necessary to timely file and execute such application and carry out the duties and conditions of the grant.




