CERTIFICATION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT APPROVAL FOR
NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS RECEIVING
EMERGENCY SHELTER GRANT (ESG) FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF IOWA

WHEREAS, the Emergency Shelter Grant ("ESG") regulations found at 24 CFR 576.25(b)(2) concerning the submission by nonprofit organizations applying for funding require a certification of approval of the proposed project from the unit of local government in which the proposed project is located; and


WHEREAS, Central Iowa Shelter & Services, a nonprofit agency located in Des Moines, has submitted a proposal to the State of Iowa for ESG funding totaling \$32,500, with \$13,000 for Community Kitchen operations and \$19,500 for shelter operations; and

WHEREAS, Central Iowa Shelter & Services has submitted the required State and Federal compliance forms and documentation and is now requesting the Des Moines City Council certification of local government approval to receive ESG funds from the State of Iowa.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute the above referenced Certification of Local Government Approval for Nonprofit Organizations Receiving ESG funds from the State of Iowa, on file with the City Clerk and by this reference made a part hereof, and the City Clerk to attest to his signature.




