APPROVING GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF DES MOINES AND THE IOWA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$562,574.00 FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AT THE DES MOINES INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.

WHEREAS, the State of Iowa has appropriated \$1,500,000 for the FY2010 Commercial Service Vertical Infrastructure Fund for the eight Iowa Commercial Service Airports; and

WHEREAS, the distribution formula will provide the Des Moines International Airport with \$562,574.00 for the current fiscal year, July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011; and

WHEREAS, on August 3, 2010, by Resolution No. A10-147, the Airport Board recommended to City Council the approval of the grant agreement between the City and the Iowa DOT providing funding for the projects;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA:

That the Iowa Department of Transportation Agreement for Capital Improvements at the Commercial Service Airports, between the City of Des Moines, Iowa, and the Iowa Department of Transportation in the amount of \$562,574.00 for Capital Improvements at Des Moines International Airport, is accepted and approved; and that the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to sign the agreement on behalf of the City of Des Moines and the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attest to the Mayor's signature.
