WHERAS, the low dollar compliant bid for Item 1 was received from Bay Communications Inc., 2040 Radison Street, Green Bay, WI 54302 (Steve Elias/President), at a total cost of \$104,725.00; and

WHERAS, the low dollar compliant bid for Item 2 was received from CDW Government, 230 North Milwaukee Avenue, Vernon Hills, IL 60061 (John Edwardson/President), at a total cost of \$5999.50; and

WHERAS, the low dollar compliant bid for Item 3 was received from Embark IT, 1303 50th Street, West Des Moines, IA 50266 (Anita Messerschmidt/President), at a total cost of \$7043.75; and

WHEREAS, funding is available from POL040900/E911 Reimbursement; and

WHEREAS, the Procurement Administrator and the Police Department recommends approval of the low dollar compliant bids;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Des Moines City Council hereby accepts and approves the low dollar compliant bids from the aforementioned bidders for twenty-five (25) replacement ToughBook Computers and associated hardware at a total cost of \$117,768.25.
