RESOLUTION APPROVING AMENDMENTS TO THE SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR FEES IMPOSED BY CHAPTER 26, BUILDINGS AND BUILDING REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, a proposed ordinance repealing and replacing Chapter 26, Building and Building Regulations, was passed on first reading on November 22, 2010; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed ordinance amends Chapter 26 to: i) to reorganize and standardize the licensing and permitting procedures; ii) to amend and adopt the 2009 editions of the International Building Code, International Residential Code, International Existing Building Code, International Mechanical Code, International Fuel Gas Code, International Energy Conservation Code, and the Uniform Plumbing Code; and iii) to delete the licensing provisions regarding electrical, mechanical and plumbing licenses that have been taken over by the state; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed amendment to the Schedule of Fees is intended to reflect the changes to the organization of Chapter 26, without changing the amount of the fees for the various permits and licenses issued pursuant to Chapter 26; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the adopted Schedule of Fees for the City of Des Moines is hereby amended by amendment of the fees imposed pursuant to Chapter 26 of the City Code to be as set forth in the accompanying schedule, effective January 1, 2011.
