AUTHORIZATION TO PROCEED WITH ACQUISITION OF REAL PROPERTY LOCALLY KNOWN AS 903 SE 22ND STREET FROM OMG MIDWEST INC. D/B/A DES MOINES ASPHALT & PAVING CO. FOR RELOCATION OF THE PUBLIC WORKS SUPPLY YARD BY VOLUNTARY NEGOTIATION

WHEREAS, City staff from various departments including the City Manager and Public Works Department have determined that it is necessary to acquire real property interests in connection with the relocation of the Public Works Supply Yard; and

WHEREAS, the real property locally known as 903 SE 22nd Street, Des Moines, owned by OMG Midwest Inc. d/b/a Des Moines Asphalt & Paving Co., is proposed by City staff to be acquired for use as the relocation site for the purchase price of \$1,200,000.00 plus closing costs, which price reflects the fair market value of the property as determined by the City's Real Estate Division; and

WHEREAS, the City's Real Estate Division of the Engineering Department will negotiate voluntary acquisition of the necessary real property for this relocation on behalf of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

- 1. That the City Manager and the City Real Estate Division be and are hereby authorized to proceed with the necessary activities and negotiations to acquire by voluntary negotiation a fee simple interest in the real property locally known as 903 SE 22nd Street from OMG Midwest Inc. d/b/a Des Moines Asphalt & Paving Co. for the purchase price of \$1,200,000.00 plus closing costs for relocation of the Public Works Supply Yard.
- 2. Following the due diligence period and subject to environmental review, the Finance Director is authorized and directed to issue checks in the amounts necessary to carry out this transaction and to pay any unforeseen additional costs certified by the Legal Department and the Engineering Department; the Real Estate Division Manager is authorized and directed to complete these transactions in accordance with standard real estate practices and state law requirements.
- 3. That the Real Estate Division of the Engineering Department is directed to obtain the Legal Department's review and approval of all closing documents prior to closing.
- 4. That the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to endorse upon the real estate documents associated with this acquisition the approval and acceptance of this Council, the Mayor is authorized and directed to sign all necessary real estate documents, and the City Clerk is further authorized and directed to deliver the aforementioned documents to the Real Estate Division Manager, who shall proceed to closing in accordance with standard real estate practices.
