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## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING VOLUNTARY ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY LOCATED IN THE 1600 BLOCK OF MAURY STREET FROM S & P PROPERTIES, L.C. FOR A PERMANENT RELOCATION SITE FOR CITY-OWNED FACILITIES BEING DISPLACED BY THE SE CONNECTOR PROJECT

- 3. That the Real Estate Division of the Engineering Department is directed to obtain the Legal Department's review and approval of all closing documents prior to closing.

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4. That the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to	endorse upon the real estate documents

That the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to endorse upon the real estate documents associated with this acquisition the approval and acceptance of this Council, the Mayor is authorized and directed to sign all necessary real estate documents, and the City Clerk is further authorized and directed to deliver the aforementioned documents to the Real Estate Division Manager, who shall proceed to closing in accordance with standard real estate practices.
