## APPROVAL OF REDUCTION IN MATCHING CONTRIBUTIONS TO SUPERVISORY, PROFESSIONAL AND MANAGEMENT ("SPM") EMPLOYEES' 457 PLAN AND GRANDFATHERING CURRENT SPM EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines offers its employees the opportunity to participate in an IRS Section 457(b) plan whereby compensation may be deferred; and

WHEREAS, Des Moines Municipal Code Section 2-454 authorizes the city council to direct city contributions to a deferred compensation plan as it deems appropriate for SPM employees; and

WHEREAS, currently the City contribution ("match") for SPM employees is up to 4.5%; and

WHEREAS, it is intended that current SPM employees will remain eligible for the 4.5% match; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to cut future costs for the City, it is desirous to reduce the city contribution to 2.5% for SPM employees appointed after December 31, 2010 except those who have accepted an offer of employment prior to that date.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa that it hereby directs that the city contribution for Supervisory, Professional and Management employees appointed after December 31, 2010 except those who have accepted an offer of employment prior to that date will be eligible for up to a 2.5% match and current SPM employees shall continue to be eligible for up to a 4.5% city contribution.
