APPROVAL OF THE PROPOSED ALIGNMENT OF THE GRAY'S LAKE NEIGHBORHOOD CONNECTING TRAIL AND ADDITION OF SUCH TRAIL TO THE CITY OF DES MOINES MULTI-USE RECREATIONAL TRAILS MASTER PLAN MAP

WHEREAS, the Park and Recreation Department is charged with providing recreational opportunities and leisure activities throughout Des Moines; and

WHEREAS, the development of multi-use recreational trails, both on-street and off-street, is a high priority for the citizens of Des Moines and the Des Moines City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department has met with representatives from the Gray's Lake Neighborhood Association to help select a route for the Gray's Lake Connecting Trail; and

WHEREAS, the Trails and Greenways Advisory Committee has reviewed and recommended approval of the proposed route to the Des Moines Park and Recreation Board on December 14, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Des Moines Park and Recreation Board approved the attached proposed alignment for the Gray's Lake Connecting Trail at its meeting on December 28, 2010.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the proposed alignment of the Gray's Lake Connecting Trail is hereby approved and the City of Des Moines Multi-Use Recreational Trails Master Plan is hereby amended to include such trail.
