AUTHORIZING GRANT APPLICATION TO THE UNITED STATES CONFERENCE OF MAYORS AND DUPONT UNDER THE LEAD SAFE FOR KIDS' SAKE! GRANT PROGRAM

WHEAREAS, the state of Iowa was the first in the nation to adopt the Environmental Protection Agency's Renovate, Repair, and Painting (RRP) rule which requires contractors working in homes built prior to 1978 to receive lead safety training; and

WHEREAS, City staff has prepared a grant application in the amount of \$75,000 under the Lead Safe for Kids' Sake! Grant Program administered by the United States Conference of Mayors and Dupont; and

WHEREAS, the grant application proposes funding of a project in partnership with the River Bend Neighborhood Association to provide lead safety training to residents through educational workshops and a demonstration project at 1720 8th Street; and

WHEREAS, the property at 1720 8th Street is owned by the River Bend Neighborhood Association and has a home that was built in 1901; and

WHEREAS, there is no match requirement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that submission of the grant application to the United States Conference of Mayors and Dupont Lead Safe for Kids' Sake! Program is hereby approved.
