WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines Police Department, with the assistance of the Des Moines Independent Community School District, is filing a grant application through the Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) Office, 2011 COPS Secure Our Schools grant program, to request funding which would bring state-of-the-art security systems to Des Moines schools; and,

WHEREAS, this project is estimated to cost \$600,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, the grant will fund up to 50% of the total cost to implement the programs; and,

WHEREAS, the Des Moines School District has agreed to provide the rest of the funding with the Police Department responsible for the administration of the grant: and,


WHEREAS, the grant is for a two-year period; 09/01/2011 to 08/30/2013




