APPROVING AND ADOPTING A SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR DOG PARK PERMITS UNDER CHAPTER 18 OF THE CITY CODE

WHEREAS, Chapter 18 of the City Code provides for the City's regulation of dogs; and

WHEREAS, section 18-55(a)(6) of the City Code allows dogs to be off-leash in an designated off-leash area in a City park or other City property, or in other non-City park provided that certain requirements are met, including a dog park permit for dogs using the dog park; and

WHEREAS, section 18-55(a)(7) of the City Code provides that the annual license fee for a dog park permit shall be in the amounts provided in a Schedule of Fees to be adopted by the City Council by resolution; and

WHEREAS, section 74-100 of the City Code allows dogs to be off-leash in City park in designated off-leash areas incompliance with section 18-55(a)(6); and

WHEREAS, at its meeting on April 1, 2011, the Park and Recreation Board approved the dog park fees in the attached Dog Park Schedule of Fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA that the Dog Park Schedule of Fees attached hereto and by this reference hereto is hereby approved and adopted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said Cemeteries Schedule of Fees shall be maintained on file in the office of the City Clerk, the Park and Recreation Department, and each City cemetery for public reference, and that the fees therein established shall become effective upon and as of June 14, 2011.
