AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2012 STATE OF IOWA
CERTIFIED LOCAL GOVERNMENT (CLG) GRANT APPLICATION TO THE
STATE HISTORICAL SOCIETY FOR AN INTENSIVE LEVEL HISTORICAL/ARCHITECTURAL
SURVEY AND POTENTIAL NOMINATION OF A NEW NATIONAL REGISTER
HISTORIC DISTRICT FOR THE RIVER BEND NEIGHBORHOOD

WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines has been deemed a Certified Local Government (CLG) by the State Historical Society of Iowa; and

WHEREAS, the State Historical Society of Iowa provides funding to CLG's for historic preservation projects and activities; and

WHEREAS, the State Historical Society of Iowa is soliciting applications for CLG grants for Fiscal Year (FY) 2012; and

WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines Community Development Department and the River Bend Neighborhood Association propose to conduct an intensive level architectural and historical survey in the area of River Bend Neighborhood that has not been previously surveyed; and


WHEREAS, the proposed intensive level historical and architectural survey of the River Bend Neighborhood will help to continue the neighborhood revitalization and historic preservation efforts in the River Bend neighborhood; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to submit a CLG grant application to the State Historical Society of Iowa for an intensive level historical and architectural survey of the River Bend Neighborhood.


