SETTING DATE OF HEARING ON AMENDMENT TO MUNICIPAL HOUSING AGENCY ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2012

WHEREAS, an amendment to the Municipal Housing Agency's annual budget for the current fiscal year ending June 30, 2012 is necessary to reflect changing estimates of revenue and expenditure, appropriations relating to cash on hand at the end of the preceding fiscal year, amounts available from revenues, adjustments in expenditures across all programs and transfers between funds and between programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Municipal Housing Governing Board that:

- The public hearing on the Amendment to the Municipal Housing Agency's annual budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012 is hereby set for the 27th day of February, 2012 at 4:00 o'clock p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa, 50309 at which time any resident or taxpayer of the City may be heard for or against the proposed budget amendment and change.

The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish notice of the hearing in the attached form in the Des Moines Register, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Des Monies, Polk County, Iowa, in accordance with Iowa Code Section 362.3, not less than four (4) nor more than twenty (20) days prior to the date set for hearing.
