APPROVING APPLICATION FOR US DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY  
2012 ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, for the 2012 program year, Congress appropriated funds to the Office for Domestic Preparedness, United States Department of Homeland Security and the authority to carry out an initiative to provide assistance to firefighters that is directed to support departments that lack the tools and resources necessary to protect the health and safety of the public and their firefighting personnel through a 2012 Assistance to Firefighters Grant program; and,

WHEREAS, such grant funds will be distributed directly to local fire departments on a competitive basis; and,

WHEREAS, the Des Moines Fire Department has prepared a grant application for nine (9) automatic chest compression devices (LUCAS 2),

WHEREAS, the total project cost is \$125,545, with the Federal grant amount of \$100,436 and the City's match of \$25,109; and,

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief recommends that the City Council authorize this application for funding from the Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the Fire Chief or his designee is authorized and directed to submit the above described grant application on behalf of the City of Des Moines to the Office for Domestic Preparedness, United States Department of Homeland Security for consideration of a \$100,436 grant.
