APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE SCHEDULE OF FEES APPLICABLE TO DRIVEWAY APPROACH AND CURB DROP PERMIT FEES

WHEREAS, Section 102-361 of the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines provides for fees for permits to construct a residential curb drop and/or driveway approach, to construct a commercial curb drop and/or driveway approach, and to construct a temporary driveway approach in the amounts set in the Schedule of Fees adopted by the City Council by resolution; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the Schedule of Fees setting permit fees for permits to construct curb drops and/or driveway approaches, both permanent and temporary, has been prepared for Council consideration and is recommended for adoption, which amendment is appended hereto and is now on file in the Office of the City Clerk.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the amendment to the Schedule of Fees appended hereto is hereby approved and adopted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to incorporate said amendment into the Schedule of Fees, and to maintain said Schedule of Fees, as amended, on file in the Office of the City Clerk for public reference, and that the fees established in said amendment shall become effective upon passage and publication of the pending ordinance amending Section 102-361 of the Municipal Code.
