REQUEST FROM LINDA K. CASAS FOR COUNCIL-INITIATED REQUEST FOR VACATION OF THE NORTH/ SOUTH ALLEY AND THE EAST HALF OF THE EAST/ WEST ALLEY LYING BETWEEN SE 8TH STREET AND SE 9TH STREET FROM SCOTT AVENUE TO SHAW STREET

WHEREAS, on October 27, 1975, by Roll Call No. 4908, City Council adopted Ordinance No. 8995 vacating various street and alley rights-of-way in the vicinity of the Chicago, Northwestern Railroad track from South Union Street to SE 11th Street; and

WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines has recently received a communication from Linda Casas, owner of the property locally known as 816 Shaw Street, requesting that the City Council initiate the vacation of the north/south alley and the remaining east/west alley right-of-way between SE 8th Street and SE 9th Street from Scott Avenue to Shaw Street which was not included in Ordinance No. 8995.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the above-described request is hereby received and filed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this matter be referred to Plan and Zoning Commission and City staff for review and recommendation, and to return to Council for further action on said request.

MOVED by Meyer to adopt; refer to the City Manager for review and recommendation regarding long-range planning and a policy on conveyance of City property in all areas where the City has a development plan in place; and to set up a public meeting with residents and businesses in the Market District area.
