RESCIND THE TRAFFIC SAFETY FUND GRANT FOR \$360,000 AWARDED TO THE CITY BY IDOT FOR THE PROPOSED HUBBELL AVENUE RESTRIPIING PROJECT FROM E 18TH STREET TO E 33RD STREET

WHEREAS, the City had previously applied for an Iowa Department of Transportation Traffic Safety Funds Grant for a project on Hubbell Avenue, four-lane to three-lane conversion; and

WHEREAS, the Iowa Department of Transportation thus offered a grant to the City; and

WHEREAS, a Council directed public engagement process resulted in a community consensus not to proceed with the proposed improvements,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to pursue other projects and re-examine Hubbell Avenue in the future and not proceed with the proposed improvement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA:


That the City Manager is hereby directed to rescind the application to the Iowa Department of Transportation for Traffic Safety Funds and return the tendered grant agreement for the following project:


