BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA: That the attached report of the Des Moines City Engineer, showing the cost of the construction of the 2011 ADA Sidewalk Ramp Program - Contract 2, 09-2011-005, in accordance with the contract approved between MPS Engineers, P.C., Umesh G. Shetye, President, 1444 Illinois Street, Des Moines, IA 50314, under Roll Call No. 11-1398, of August 8, 2011, and the City of Des Moines, and recommending the acceptance thereof, be and the same is hereby approved, and accepted, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That \$439,088.70 is the total cost, of which \$409,185.17 has been paid the Contractor, and \$16,730.87 is now due and is hereby approved as final partial payment for the above project, the remaining balance of \$13,172.66 is to be paid at the end of thirty days, with funds retained for unresolved claims on file in accordance with Iowa Code Chapter 573.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Des Moines Finance Director be and is hereby authorized to release said retainage if suit is not filed as above provided.
