ORDERING CONSTRUCTION OF
SE CONNECTOR PAVING - S.E. 15TH STREET TO S.E. 30TH STREET
AND FIXING A DATE FOR RECEIVING OF BIDS ON MAY 21, 2013
AND PUBLIC HEARING ON JUNE 10, 2013
ENGINEER'S ESTIMATE IS \$29,004,874.76

WHEREAS, this Council deems it advisable and necessary to construct the below referenced improvement, all in accordance with the plans and specifications, and has caused to be prepared plans, specifications, and form of contract, together with estimate of cost, which are now on file in the City Engineer's Office, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa 50309-1891, for public inspection for the construction of said improvements, and said plans, specifications and form of contract are deemed suitable for the making of said improvement, for which the State of Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) and the City of Des Moines, (CITY) have an agreement, previously approved by this Council, under which the IDOT has agreed to advertise, receive, open and tabulate sealed bids, and

WHEREAS, before said plans, specifications, form of contract, and estimated cost of the improvement may be approved, and contract for the construction of the improvement entered into, it is necessary to hold a public hearing.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA: That the attached communication recommending construction of the following improvement and the method of financing; and also including the recommendation of the Des Moines City Engineer, as the Engineer, submitting plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and Engineer's estimate of cost for the construction of the following improvement:

SE Connector Paving - S.E. 15th Street to S.E. 30th Street, 06-2012-006

NHS-U-1945(409) -8G-77, NHS-U-1945(409)- -8G-77, NHS-U-1945(409)--8G-77, NHS-U-1945(409)-8G-77

The improvement includes construction of two bridges over Union Pacific and Norfolk Southern railroad properties and construction of a Portland Cement Pavement ten inches thick on the Southeast Connector, S.E. 18th Street, S.E. 23rd Street and S.E. 25th Court with various width pavements and medians; together with the necessary removals, earthwork, clearing, grubbing, erosion control, sidewalks, driveways, recreational trails, pavement subdrains, storm sewers, traffic control, traffic signals, street lighting, intersection enhancements, and landscaping; all in accordance with the contract documents including Plan File Nos. 550-001/753 on the Southeast Connector from S.E. 15th Street to S.E. 30th Street, Des Moines, Iowa

be and the same are hereby approved and accepted. The estimated construction cost for said improvement is \$29,004,874.76. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That this Council hereby determines that it is necessary and advisable to construct said improvement in the manner set forth in the plans, specifications, and form of contract documents submitted by the Engineer; and that payment for the cost of said improvement shall be paid from the funding source identified below.



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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That a public hearing on said plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and Engineer's estimate of construction cost for said improvement be held in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa, at 5:00 p.m. on June 10, 2013, at which time this Council will consider any objections offered thereto or to the making of said improvement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That proposals will be received by the Iowa Department of Transportation, for the construction of said improvements, and the taking of bids in the manner required by law. Proposals received will be opened and tabulated by the Iowa Department of Transportation on May 21, 2013, after which the bids together with a report and recommendation of the Chief Civil Engineer, will be presented to City Council at its next meeting for action thereon.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That an appropriate Notice to Bidders and Notice of Public Hearing for said improvement be published in the Des Moines Register as provided and directed by Chapter 26 and/or 314, Code of Iowa.

Funding Source: 2013-2014 CIP, Page Street - 36, Southeast Connector - S.E. 14th Street to S.E. 30th Street, STR249, Being: \$10,000,000 (maximum) in Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery (TIGER) Discretionary Grant Federal Earmark, being 80% eligible for grading, paving and bridge construction costs under NHS-U-1945(409)-8G-77; \$8,014,799.46 in Federal Surface Transportation Program (STP) funds being 80% eligible for roadway construction costs allocated through Des Moines Area MPO under NHS-U-1945(409)-8G-77; \$8,556,841.16 in IDOT - RISE funds being 50% eligible; \$219,820 from Des Moines Water Works for water main construction; and the remaining \$2,213,414.14 in G.O. Bonds to be issued. Note - the \$8,014,799.46 in Federal funding allocated by the MPO will not be available when construction begins; the maximum MPO funding includes \$4,208,000 available now, \$1,517,000 in Federal FY15, and \$3,229,000 in Federal FY16; current Federal legislation extends through Federal FY14; Federal funds for projects beyond 2013 are estimated based on current funding levels, and may be reduced; the City of Des Moines is responsible for STP funding required in excess of \$4,208,000, which is expected to be reimbursed when available in FY15 & FY16.
