RESOLUTION SCHEDULING PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED RENAMING OF THE SEGMENT OF THE SOUTHWEST CONNECTOR LOCATED WEST OF IOWA HIGHWAY 28 TO VETERANS PARKWAY

WHEREAS, the City staff have requested that the segment of the Southwest Connector extending west from Iowa Highway 28 to the west City boundary be renamed "Veterans Parkway" to better coordinate emergency response services between jurisdictions and to eliminate the confusion created by one block of street having two names; and,

WHEREAS, the City Plan and Zoning Commission has advised that at a public hearing held on February 6, 2014, its members voted 9-0 in support of a motion to recommend **APPROVAL** of the proposed street renaming.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa as follows:

- 1. That the City Council consider the proposal to rename the segment of the Southwest Connector west of Iowa Highway 28 to "Veterans Parkway" at a public hearing to be held in the Council Chambers at 5:00 p.m. on March 10, 2014, at which time the City Council will hear both those who oppose and those who favor the proposal.
- 2. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause notice of said proposal in the accompanying form to be given by publication once, not less than four (4) days and not more than twenty (20) days before the date of hearing.
