ORDERING CONSTRUCTION OF
2014 CITY-WIDE PCC PAVEMENT RESTORATION PROGRAM
AND FIXING A DATE FOR RECEIVING OF BIDS ON MAY 20, 2014
AND PUBLIC HEARING ON JUNE 9, 2014
ENGINEER'S ESTIMATE IS \$443,100.00

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA: That the attached communication recommending construction of the following improvement and the method of financing; and also including the recommendation of the Des Moines City Engineer, as the Engineer, submitting plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and Engineer's estimate of cost for the construction of the following improvement:

2014 City-wide PCC Pavement Restoration Program, 06-2014-009

The improvement includes furnishing, placing, curing, sawing, and sealing PCC pavement patches of various thickness in a cooperative effort with the City of Des Moines, Public Works Department, at the following locations in Des Moines, Iowa:

48th Street from Bel Aire Road to Crestmoor Drive
Shawnee Avenue from 42nd Street to 43rd Street
Ohio Street from Indiana Avenue to College Avenue
Madison Avenue from 14th Street to 12th Street
Ovid Avenue from E. 38th Street to E. 42nd Street
E. 35th Court from E. University Avenue to Garfield Avenue
Grand Avenue from 59th Street to 62nd Street
59th Street from Grand Avenue to 100 feet north of Grand Avenue
Grand Avenue from 56th Street to 58th Street
15th Street from Woodland Avenue to Center Street
E. 29th Street from Maple Avenue (to west) to Maple Avenue (to east)
Pioneer Road from S.E. 6th Street to S.E. 8th Street
S.E. 17th Street from Glenwood Drive to King Avenue
Glenwood Drive from S.E. 17th Street (to north) to S.E. 17th Street (to south)
S.W. 7th Street from Watrous Avenue to Maish Avenue
S.E. 8th Street from Hart Avenue to Porter Avenue
S.E. 8th Street from E. Diehl Avenue to south of E. Diehl Avenue
Indianola Avenue from U.S. 69 to asphalt east of U.S. 69

be and the same are hereby approved and accepted. The estimated construction cost for said improvement is \$443,100.00. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That this Council hereby determines that it is necessary and advisable to construct said improvement in the manner set forth in the plans, specifications, and form of contract documents submitted by the Engineer; and that payment for the cost of said improvement shall be paid from the funding source identified below.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That a public hearing on said plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and Engineer's estimate of construction cost for said improvement be held in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa, at 5:00 p.m. on June 9, 2014, at which time this Council will consider any objections offered thereto or to the making of said improvement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That proposals will be received by the City of Des Moines, at the office of the Des Moines City Clerk until 11:00 a.m. on May 20, 2014, for the construction of said improvement, and the taking of bids in the manner required by law. Proposals received will be opened at a public meeting presided over by the Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa, at 11:00 a.m. on May 20, 2014, after which the bids together with a bid tabulation and recommendation of the Engineer will be presented to the City Council at its next meeting for action thereon.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That an appropriate Notice to Bidders and Notice of Public Hearing for said improvement be published in the Des Moines Register as provided and directed by Chapter 26 and/or 314, Code of Iowa.
