RESOLUTION SCHEDULING PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE ZONING ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE ALLOWED LOCATION AND OPERATION OF TOBACCO STORES THAT SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR OFF PREMISES CONSUMPTION

WHEREAS, the City Plan and Zoning Commission has advised that at a public hearing held on May 1, 2014, its members voted ___-___-___ in support of a motion to recommend APPROVAL of proposed amendments to the Zoning Ordinance to define tobacco store and to regulate the allowed location and operation of tobacco stores that sell alcoholic beverages for off premises consumption, as more fully shown by Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, as follows:

- 1. That the meeting of the City Council at which the proposed amendments to the Zoning Ordinance are to be considered shall be held in the Council Chambers at City Hall at 5:00 p.m. on May 19, 2014, at which time the City Council will hear both those who oppose and those who favor the proposal.
2. That the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause notice of said proposal in the accompanying form to be given by publication once, not less than seven (7) days and not more than twenty (20) days before the date of hearing, all as specified in Section 362.3 and Section 414.4 of the Iowa Code.
