RESOLUTION WITH RESPECT TO PUBLIC HEARING ON THE AUTHORIZATION OF A LEASE AGREEMENT FOR THE RENTAL OF ONE REFUSE TRUCK FOR MONTHLY LEASE PAYMENTS OF \$7,800 EACH

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 364.4 and 384.83 of the Code of Iowa, notice of the hearing on the proposed authorization of a Lease Agreement between the City of Des Moines and Scranton Manufacturing Co., Inc. for the rental of one refuse truck to be used for the removal of solid waste by the Solid Waste Division of the Department of Public Works, said lease agreement being up to an eight month period with monthly lease payments of \$7,800 each to be paid from the Solid Waste Operations Enterprise Fund, and of the proposed action by the City Council to institute proceedings for the authorization of said Lease Agreement for the above purposes, has been duly published as provided by law; and

WHEREAS, the public meeting and hearing has been duly held at the time and place provided and in accordance with said notice and oral or written objections were received and filed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

That the time for receiving oral and written objections be closed and the proposal for the authorization of said Lease agreement and all objections thereto be taken under consideration by the Council.
