AUTHORIZATION TO NEGOTIATE SEVERANCE OF OAKWOOD DRIVE AND THE ADJOINING PROPERTIES FROM THE CITY OF DES MOINES FOR ANNEXATION INTO PLEASANT HILL

WHEREAS, Pleasant Hill has asked that Des Moines improve the short segment of Oakwood Drive in Des Moines located between Scott Avenue and the east Des Moines boundary at an estimated cost of approximately \$160,000; and,

WHEREAS, the improvement of this segment of Oakwood Drive would primarily benefit the citizens of Pleasant Hill; and,

WHEREAS, the properties adjoining this segment of Oakwood Drive cannot be economically served by the Des Moines public sewer system, but could be served from the public sanitary sewer line in Scott Avenue owned by Pleasant Hill; and,

WHEREAS, the City staff recommend that the City of Des Moines explore the potential of severing this segment of Oakwood Drive, the adjoining properties, and possibly a segment of Scott Avenue, all as shown by the accompanying Council Communication, for annexation into Pleasant Hill.
