RESOLUTION CONTINUING HEARING ON THE PROPOSED ECHO VALLEY URBAN RENEWAL PLAN

WHEREAS, the proposed Echo Valley Urban Renewal Area contains approximately 332 acres west of Fleur Drive, north of Border Street, east of SW 28th Street (also known as 80th Avenue in unincorporated Warren County), and south of Echo Valley Drive, all as shown by the accompanying map; and,

WHEREAS, on June 22, 2015, by Roll Call No. 15-1021, the City Council resolved that a public hearing on the proposed Echo Valley Urban Renewal Plan be held on July 27, 2015, in the City Council Chambers; and,

WHEREAS, the City Office of Economic Development has requested that the public hearing on the Echo Valley Urban Renewal Plan be continued until August 24, 2015, to allow a neighborhood meeting to be held with the affected property owners and residents.

MOVED by Hensley to continue the public hearing on the Echo Valley Urban Renewal Plan until August 24, 2015, at 5:00 p.m., in the Council Chambers at City Hall.
