BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA: That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, an Agreement between the Department of the Army, and the City of Des Moines for the Des Moines Levees System, Des Moines and Raccoon Rivers, IA, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk.
