## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING RELEASE OF RESERVED UTILITY EASEMENTS LOCATED AT 1300 KEOSAUQUA WAY

WHEREAS, Sercl OK LLC, an affiliate of Kum & Go LC, is the owner of 1300 Keosauqua Way ("Property") and is in the process of redeveloping the Property; and

WHEREAS, portions of the Property formally were City of Des Moines streets and alleys that were vacated and conveyed by the City to the predecessor(s) in interest to Sercl OK LLC, and are described in the following documents recorded with the Polk County Recorder:

- 2. Quit Claim Deed filed October 19, 1956 at Book 2914, Page 296

WHEREAS, in all of the above-referenced Quit Claim Deeds and Ordinances, the City reserved a general easement for public utilities in place at the time that each document was recorded; and

WHEREAS, Sercl OK, L.L.C. has requested that the easement reservation for utilities upon said Property, as included in each of the above-referenced Quit Claim Deeds and Ordinances, be released by the City of Des Moines, and Sercl OK LLC has further provided an affidavit from Michael A. Brooner, Licensed Professional Land Surveyor of Civil Design Advantage LLC, stating that by both topographic survey and Iowa One Call, it has been determined that no public utilities are shown within the properties described in the above-referenced Quit Claim Deeds and Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, City staff have also determined that the City has no need for the existing easement reservations for utilities upon the Property as included in the above-referenced Quit Claim Deeds and Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that:

- 1. There is no public need for, and the public would not be inconvenienced by reason of the release of, the City's utility easement reservations as set forth in the above-listed Quit Claim Deeds and Ordinances.
- 2. The release of such City utility easement reservations be and is hereby approved.
- 3. The Mayor is authorized and directed to sign the Termination and Release of Easement, and the City Clerk is authorized and directed to attest to the Mayor's signature.
