WHEREAS, the Police Department requested the Procurement Division to purchase replacement parts for the eight bomb disarmament robots used by Iowa's Explosive Ordinance Disposal (EOD) Task Force Teams (one of which is retained by the City of Des Moines Bomb Squad); and

WHEREAS, the Procurement Administrator has determined that such equipment is available from Northrop Grumman - Remotec, Inc. 353 JD Yarnell Industrial Parkway, Clinton, Tennessee 37716, Wes Bush Chief Executive Officer and President, Northrop Grumman Corporation, the manufacturer and sole area wide distributor; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Code section 2-726 (a)(7) provides for a non-competitive procurement of goods and/or services that are of such a nature that they are the only goods and/or services which will fit and comply with the required use, or are an integral part of a total system so as to be uniquely compatible with existing city need, materials or equipment to be cost effective; and

WHEREAS, funding is available from HSP00015/Homeland Security EOD grant; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Des Moines City Council hereby accepts and approves the non-competitive purchase of replacement parts for bomb disarmament robots from Northrop Grumman - Remotec, Inc. at a total cost of \$98,000.00.
