WHEREAS, Municipal Code section 2-726(f) provides for the procurement of goods and/or services from contracts that have been competitively established through the Western States Contracting Alliance and other cooperative contracting consortiums for state government departments, institutions, agencies and political subdivisions, without conforming to the competitive bidding requirements of the Procurement Division; and
