PUBLIC HEARING, APPROVING PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS, FORM OF CONTRACT DOCUMENTS, AND ENGINEER'S ESTIMATE ON SOUTH UNION STREET BRIDGE OVER MIDDLE SOUTH CREEK REPLACEMENT; RECEIVE AND FILE BIDS; AND DESIGNATION OF LOWEST RESPONSIVE, RESPONSIBLE BIDDER AS HERBERGER CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC., DEAN HERBERGER, PRESIDENT, \$839,298.87

WHEREAS, on August 22, 2016, under Roll Call No. 16-1382, plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and Engineer's estimate of construction cost were filed with the City Clerk, for the construction of the following improvement:

South Union Street Bridge over Middle South Creek Replacement, 12-2014-001
BROS-1945(803)--8J-91

The improvement includes removal of the existing single span steel pony truss bridge, construction of a new continuous concrete slab bridge on steel pile foundations, bridge open rail, tree removal, approach grading and granular surfacing, approach guardrail, channel shaping and revetment, erosion control, wetland mitigation, seeding, traffic control, temporary access, and mobilization; all work in accordance with the contract documents including Plan File Nos. 573-181/222, on South Union Street over Middle South Creek located south of Highway 5 in Warren County in Des Moines, Iowa

WHEREAS, notice of the hearing on the plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and Engineer's estimate of construction cost was published as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA: That the hearing on the plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and Engineer's estimate of construction cost for said improvement be closed; and that said plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and Engineer's estimate of construction cost are hereby approved as the plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and Engineer's estimate of construction cost for said improvement.
