APPROVAL OF SUBMISSION OF THE YOUTH HOMELESSNESS DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD)

WHEREAS, in response to a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for a Youth Homelessness Demonstration Program published in the Federal Register to supplement funding for local youth homeless programs, the Polk County Iowa Continuum of Care Board prepared a grant application to be submitted to HUD for funding approval; and

WHEREAS, the application, if awarded, will require the community, including Des Moines and Polk County, to put together a plan to address youth homelessness in the community and provide funding to implement the programs identified in the plan to eliminate youth homelessness.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that submittal of the above referenced Continuum of Care grant application is hereby approved; that the City Manager or his designee is hereby directed to execute any necessary documents included in the grant application and submit the application to HUD; and that if received, the funding, program requirements, and grant agreement will be returned to Council for consideration and approval.
