APPROVING A 28E AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF DES MOINES AND POLK COUNTY FOR AMBULANCE AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE (EMS) TO THE POLK COUNTY JAIL

WHEREAS, the City, through its Fire Department, provides persons within the corporate limits of the City of Des Moines with ambulance transport service and emergency medical service (EMS) and is willing to provide such services to the Polk County Jail, located at 1985 Northeast 51st Place, Des Moines Iowa 50313; and

WHEREAS, Polk County deems it to be in the best interests of Polk County that such ambulance and EMT service be provided to the Polk County Jail for the safety and welfare of the inhabitants and County employees of the jail; and

WHEREAS, Iowa Code section 28E.32 provides that a municipality may provide emergency medical service to another city or to a county.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA, that the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to sign said Agreement Providing Ambulance and Emergency Medical Services (EMS) to the Polk County Jail for and on behalf of the City of Des Moines, Iowa and the City Clerk is directed to attest to his signature and to record such Agreement with the Iowa Secretary of State.
