RESOLUTION APPROVING DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT WITH H. GLASS PARTNERS, LLC FOR THE REDEVELOPMENT OF PROPERTY LOCATED AT 212 E. 3RD STREET, AND APPROVING PROPOSED CONCEPTUAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, on April 3, 2017, by Roll Call No. 17-0587, the City Council received Council Communication No. 17-329 setting forth a developer-initiated proposal and preliminary terms of agreement with H. Glass Partners, LLC (represented by Jeremy Cortright, Paul Cownie, and Tim Rypma) (“Developer”) for restoration and redevelopment of the existing 10,500-square foot building located at 212 E. 3rd Street (“Property”) and located in the City’s East Village with upper-floor office use and ground floor restaurant or retail use (“Project”), and directing the City Manager to proceed with negotiation of a development agreement consistent with said proposal and preliminary terms; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has negotiated an Urban Renewal Development Agreement (the “Development Agreement”) with the Developer, whereby the Developer has agreed to construct the Project, in accordance with a City-approved site plan and the Conceptual Development Plan, with a total project cost estimated at \$2.9 million; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Development Agreement and the Conceptual Development Plan related thereto are on file and available for inspection in the office of the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Development Agreement provides that in consideration of the undertakings by Developer, the City shall provide economic development assistance for redevelopment of the Property in the form of an Economic Development Grant to be paid in 30 semi-annual installments, with each installment to be in a percentage established in the Development Agreement, starting at 90 percent in the first year and decreasing over the duration of the Agreement to 75 percent in the thirteenth year, of the incremental taxes generated by redevelopment of the Property, excluding tax levy and taxes generated by the Downtown Des Moines Self-Supported Municipal Improvement District, in the estimated total amount of approximately \$420,000; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting on April 11, 2017, a consensus of the present members of the Urban Design Review Board voted in support of a motion to recommend approval of final design as proposed by the Developer and set forth in the Conceptual Development Plan attached to the Development Agreement, and approval of financial assistance as set forth above and in said Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that:

1. The City Council hereby makes the following findings in support of the proposed Development Agreement with H. Glass Partners, LLC (Developer):
 - a. Developer’s obligations under the Development Agreement to construct the Improvements furthers the objectives of the Metro Center Urban Renewal Plan to preserve and create an environment which will protect the health, safety and general welfare of City residents, and maintain taxable values and employment opportunities within the Urban Renewal Project Area.
 - b. The economic development incentives for the development of the Improvements are provided by the City pursuant to the Urban Renewal Law and Chapter 15A of the Code of Iowa, and Developer’s obligations under the Agreement to construct the Improvements will generate the following public gains and benefits: (i) it will restore vacant, undeveloped property to productive use; (ii) it will advance the improvement and redevelopment of the Urban Renewal Project Area in accordance with the Urban Renewal Plan; (iii) it will encourage further private investment to reverse the pattern of



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- c. The construction of the Improvements is a speculative venture and the construction and resulting employment and redevelopment opportunities would not occur without the economic incentives provided by the Development Agreement.
- d. The redevelopment of the Property pursuant to the Development Agreement, and the fulfillment generally of the Agreement, are in the vital and best interests of City and the health, safety, morals, and welfare of its residents, and in accord with the public purposes and provisions of the applicable state and local laws and requirements under which the project has been undertaken, and warrant the provision of the economic assistance set forth in the Agreement.

2. The Urban Renewal Development Agreement between the City and H. Glass Partners, LLC, and the Conceptual Development Plan attached thereto, both as on file in the office of the City Clerk, are hereby approved, and the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute the Agreement on behalf of the City of Des Moines.

3. Upon requisition by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, the Finance Department shall advance the installments on the Economic Development Assistance pursuant to Article 4 of the Development Agreement.

4. The City Manager or his designees are hereby authorized and directed to administer the Development Agreement on behalf of the City, and to monitor compliance by the Developer with the terms and conditions of the Agreement. The City Manager is further directed to forward to City Council all matters and documents that require City Council review and approval in accordance with the Agreement.
