AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT WITH CARNEY & APPLEBY, PLC TO PROVIDE STATE LEGISLATIVE LOBBYING SERVICES

WHEREAS, State legislation and funding issues have significant impact on City services and infrastructure; and-

WHEREAS, on November 7, 2016, by Roll Call No. 16- 1928, the City Council approved an Agreement for State Legislative Lobbying Services in which Carney & Appleby, P.L.C. provides State legislative lobbying services representing the City's interests with the Iowa legislature for an annual fee of \$42,000; and

WHEREAS, during the 2017 legislative session, Carney & Appleby, P.L.C. provided services on additional issues and increased communications with City staff and Council members, along with additional services including media communications, beyond the scope of services provided for in the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, City staff have negotiated an Amendment to the Agreement, a copy of which is on file in the City Clerk's Office, to add such additional services and to increase the annual payment to \$55,000 in order to compensate Carny & Appleby, P.L.C. for all services rendered, beginning with the June 2017 monthly payment for services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the above described Amendment to Agreement for State Legislative Lobbying Services is hereby approved and the City Manager is authorized to execute such Amendment on behalf of the City.
