WHEREAS, the Police Department requested the Finance Department Procurement Division to order an upgrade to the city's existing Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system; and

WHEREAS, the Procurement Administrator has determined that such an upgrade is available from Intergraph Corporation, dba Hexagon Safety & Infrastructure, 305 Intergraph Way, Madison, AL 35758, Steven Cost, President, the manufacturer and sole area wide distributor; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Code section 2-726 (a) (7) provides for a non-competitive procurement of goods and/or services that are of such a nature that they are the only goods and/or services which will fit and comply with the required use, or are an integral part of a total system so as to be uniquely compatible with existing city need, materials or equipment to be cost effective; and

WHEREAS, \$402,315.20, of the funding is available from E911 Reimbursement, and \$202,641.00 of the funding is provided by Polk County.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Des Moines City Council hereby accepts and approves the non-competitive purchase of an upgrade to the city's CAD system at a total cost of \$604,956.20.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager, or his designee, is directed and authorized to negotiate and execute all implementing agreements for such upgrade and future upgrades for the CAD system, subject to approval as to form by the Legal Department.
