CERTIFICATION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT APPROVAL FOR NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS TO RECEIVE EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANT (ESG) FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF IOWA

WHEREAS, United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Regulations (24 CFR 576.25(b)(2)) regarding Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) applications for funding submitted by nonprofit organizations require a certification of approval of the proposed projects from the unit of local government in which the proposed projects are located; and

WHEREAS, the Iowa Finance Authority (IFA) has forwarded to the Community Development Department the attached certification forms for projects proposed by Children & Families of Iowa, Central Iowa Shelter & Services, and Hawthorn Hill, which all have applied for State ESG funds, and IFA is requesting that the City of Des Moines certify approval for these proposed projects in order for said local nonprofit agencies to receive ESG funding from the State.
