RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR POLK COUNTY CONSERVATIONS APPLICATION TO NAME AN UNNAMED CREEK WITHIN THE EASTER LAKE WATERSHED TO MAGNOLIA CREEK

WHEREFORE, The City of Des Moines has been requested by the Polk County Conservation Commission to support its request to the US Geological Survey to name an unnamed creek within the Easter Lake Watershed to Magnolia Creek; and,

WHEREAS, Polk county Conservation Commission has been working on improving the Easter Lake Watershed as part of a multi-million-dollar public partnership with the City of Des Moines and the Iowa Department of Natural Resources and naming the creek will enhance the project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that: the City of Des Moines supports the request of the Polk County Conservation Commission to U.S. Geographic Survey that the name the unnamed creek within the Easter Lake Watershed be changed to Magnolia Creek and directs the City Manager or his designee to take any further action necessary to inform the US Geographical Survey of this support.
