**SETTING DATE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND APPROVING PUBLICATION OF
NOTICE OF HEARING TO REVIEW THE ANTICIPATED ENVIRONMENTAL
IMPACT OF RIVER BEND AND KING IRVING SEWER SEPARATION PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines developed a Long Term Control Plan (hereinafter "Plan") to eliminate combined sewer overflows as submitted to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources (IDNR) in compliance with the current National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for the operation of Wastewater Collection System and the Consent Decree with the IDNR dated April 28, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the River Bend and King Irving Sewer Separation Project (hereinafter "Project") was developed as part of said Plan and includes the removal of storm water inlets from the combined sewer system tributary to the 2nd Avenue and Franklin Avenue Combined Sewer Overflow and other flows into the combined sewer system within the project area; and

WHEREAS, the Project area is located north of downtown Des Moines and is bounded on the east by 2nd Avenue, to the south by I-235, to the west by 12th Street, and the Des Moines River to the north; and

WHEREAS, the City anticipates applying with the State of Iowa Clean Water State Revolving Fund loan program to fund the Project in part; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of the State of Iowa Clean Water State Revolving Fund loan program, before the City can proceed with the Project, the City must hold a public hearing to inform area residents of the proposed Project, to discuss the potential environmental impact of the proposed Project to the community as determined by the State's Department of Natural Resources (DNR) Environmental Review, to discuss the City's facility plan for the Project, and to address area residents' concerns, if any, with the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that:

A public hearing shall be held on November 20, 2017, at 5:00 p.m. in the City Council Chamber, Richard A. Clark Municipal Service Center, 1551 E. Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway, Des Moines, Iowa.

The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish notice of said hearing twice: once before October 20, 2017, and again during the week of November 6, 2017. The publication by the City Clerk of the time and place of this public hearing, as required by the State of Iowa under its Clean Water State Revolving Fund loan program, is hereby approved.
