**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING FAIR MARKET VALUE OF PROPERTIES OWNED BY ROY MIKESELL AT 503, 505 AND 513 SE 10<sup>TH</sup> STREET FOR THE SE 9<sup>TH</sup> STREET STORM WATER PUMP STATION PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, on September 11, 2017, by Roll Call No. 17-1550, the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa authorized the acquisition, by gift, negotiation, or eminent domain, of the necessary property interests required for the SE 9<sup>th</sup> Street Storm Water Pump Station Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the following properties have been appraised by an independent appraiser; and

**WHEREAS**, based upon the appraisal, the suggested fair market value of the property interests to be acquired are as follows:

Titleholder:	Roy Mikesell
Property Location:	503, 505 and 513 SE 10 <sup>th</sup> Street, Des Moines, IA 50309
Property Interest to Be Acquired:	Total Fee Acquisition
Suggested Fair Market Value:	\$82,000.00 (plus closing costs)

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

That the valuation listed and identified above as "Suggested Fair Market Value" is hereby established as the fair market value of the property interests listed herein.

That the Real Estate Division of the Engineering Department is authorized and directed to acquire said property interests through gift, negotiation or condemnation based upon the approved fair market value listed above.

That the property interests will be acquired in accordance with the guidelines of 49 CFR Part 24 of the Uniform Relocation and Real Property Acquisition Act, as revised, and that relocation is hereby authorized.

If the property owner agrees to convey said property interests to the City in an amount based on the established fair market value, including an approved administrative settlement, or if a condemnation award is based on the established fair market value or falls within an approved settlement amount, the Finance Director is authorized and directed to issue checks in the amounts necessary to carry out these transactions and to pay any unforeseen additional costs certified by the Legal Department and the Engineering Department; the Real Estate Division Manager is authorized and directed to complete these transactions in accordance with standard real estate practices and state law requirements.

That the Real Estate Division of the Engineering Department is directed to obtain the Legal Department's review and approval of all closing documents prior to closing.
