 REGARDING REQUEST FROM WOODLAND HEIGHTS ORGANIZATION FOR VACATION OF  
 RIGHT-OF-WAY LOCATED AT 860 MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. PARKWAY**

**WHEREAS**, the City Plan and Zoning Commission has advised that at a public hearing held on November 2, 2017, its members voted 12-0 to recommend **APPROVAL** of a request from the Woodland Heights Organization (lessee), represented by Douglas McBride (officer), for vacation of a segment of right-of-way located along the west side of Martin Luther King, Jr. Parkway south of the intersection with Cottage Grove Avenue, in the vicinity of 860 Martin Luther King, Jr. Parkway, to allow for construction of a sign to identify the Woodland Heights Organization Neighborhood Association, subject to the reservation of any necessary easements for all existing utilities in place until such time that they are abandoned or are relocated.
