APPROVING REVISED STRATEGY FOR DOWNTOWN PARKING

WHEREAS, on May 8, 2017, proposed ideas for City of Des Moines parking were presented at a City Council Workshop with a goal to manage on-street and off-street parking to support area businesses and a changing 24-7 downtown with a mix of retail, restaurant, and residential development; and

WHEREAS, City staff has worked with area business owners, residents, and employees to address the concerns related to parking and developing a revised parking strategy to better serve an evolving downtown.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA, that the revised downtown parking strategy set forth in the attached Council Communication with the stated purposes to increase available parking in downtown by adding more on-street parking spaces, creating free parking areas, changing rates and times at the parking meters and parking ramps, and to create a system that is simple and fair for residents, businesses, owners, employees, customers, and visitors, and with the stated goals and timeline is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager and his designees are hereby authorized and directed to implement the revised downtown parking strategy and to forward to the City Council for consideration and approval all ordinance amendments required for such implementation.
