WHEREAS, Municipal Code section 2-726(k) provides for the purchase of goods and/or services from contracts established by the State of Iowa Department of Administrative Services, the Iowa Department of Transportation, or the Iowa Communications Network pursuant to procedures established by Iowa Code Chapter 8A and rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, without conforming to the competitive bidding requirements of the Procurement Division; and

WHEREAS, funding is available from C051IT99/MS001, CIP/City Wide Information Systems; and

WHEREAS, the Procurement Administrator and the IT Department recommend approval of the purchase of Cisco network equipment per State of Iowa Contract 4846-15,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Des Moines City Council hereby approves the State of Iowa contract purchase of replacement Cisco network equipment from Heartland Business Systems, at a total cost of \$86,400.00.
