ORDERING CONSTRUCTION OF
2018 NEIGHBORHOOD SIDEWALK PROGRAM
AND FIXING A DATE FOR RECEIVING OF BIDS ON APRIL 10, 2018
AND PUBLIC HEARING ON APRIL 23, 2018
ENGINEER'S ESTIMATE IS \$302,400.00

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA: That the attached communication recommending construction of the following improvement and the method of financing; and also including the recommendation of the Des Moines City Engineer, as the Engineer, submitting plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and Engineer's estimate of cost for the construction of the following improvement:

2018 Neighborhood Sidewalk Program, 09-2018-005

The following improvements include furnishing labor, equipment, and materials all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 593-172/178, at the following locations all within the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Removal and reconstruction of Class A and Class B Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) sidewalks, grading and construction of new PCC sidewalks, and the removal and reconstruction of brick sidewalks. Sidewalks will be replaced and constructed at locations inspected and identified by the City of Des Moines Engineering Department within the Capitol Park Neighborhood as a part of the Step It Up - Infrastructure Improvements Program.

Grading and construction of new PCC sidewalk near the following locations inspected and identified by the City of Des Moines Engineering Department:

- Euclid Avenue from 27th Street to 30th Street
- Stanton Avenue from Fleur Drive to S.W. 26th Street
- 1530 E. Euclid Avenue
- S.E. 5th Street and Hartford Avenue
- S.W. 63rd Street and Veterans Parkway
- S.W. 42nd Street and Army Post Road
- Thomas Beck Road and Crown Colony Court
- Easter Lake Trail Connection.

Removal of PCC curb and sidewalk, and construction of PCC doweled median over existing PCC pavement near the following location inspected and identified by the City of Des Moines Engineering Department:
48th Street and University Avenue.

In the vicinity where sidewalks will be constructed, curb ramps compliant with the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 and the regulations associated with this law as it applies to pedestrian facilities will also be constructed,

be and the same are hereby approved and accepted. The estimated construction cost for said improvement is \$302,400.00. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.

Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa, at 5:00 p.m. on April 23, 2018, at which time this Council will consider any objections offered thereto or to the making of said improvement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That proposals will be received by the City of Des Moines, at the office of the Des Moines City Clerk until 11:00 a.m. on April 10, 2018, for the construction of said improvement, and the taking of bids in the manner required by law. Proposals received will be opened at a public meeting presided over by the Engineer in the City Offices, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa, at 11:00 a.m. on April 10, 2018, after which the bids together with a bid tabulation and recommendation of the Engineer will be presented to the City Council at its next meeting for action thereon.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That an appropriate Notice to Bidders for said improvement be posted, and Notice of Public Hearing for said improvement be published in the Des Moines Register, all as provided and directed by Chapter 26 and/or 314, Code of Iowa.
