AMENDING THE ACTION FOR THE REMOVAL OF EXISTING TRAFFIC CIRCLES AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF SE 24TH STREET AND E PORTER AVENUE AND SE 24TH STREET AND HART AVENUE TO INSTALL ALL-WAY STOP CONTROL

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2018, by Roll Call 18-0438, Council approved the removal of the existing traffic circles at SE 24th Street and E Porter Avenue and SE 24th Street and Hart Avenue which included that, if the traffic circles are removed, the intersections would stay as two-way stop control; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic and Transportation Division staff has determined that neither intersection meet the warrants for an all-way stop provided in the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices; and

WHEREAS, City Council has heard comments and concerns of area residents and has considered these other concerns along with those presented by the Traffic and Transportation Division, and hereby exercises its discretion in determining an all-way stop to be the traffic control needed at these intersections.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, hereby exercises its discretion in determining an all-way stop to be the traffic control needed at the intersections of SE 24th Street and E Porter Avenue and SE 24th Street and Hart Avenue approves the removal of the existing traffic circles and the installation of all-way stop control at these intersections.
