## ABATEMENT OF PUBLIC NUISANCE AT 1106 OAK PARK AVENUE

WHEREAS, the property located at 1106 Oak Park Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa, was inspected by representatives of the City of Des Moines who determined that the main structure in its present condition constitutes not only a menace to health and safety but is also a public nuisance; and

WHEREAS, the Titleholder, Molly A. Hiscox; and Mortgage Holder, US Bank, N.A., were notified more than thirty days ago to repair or demolish the main structure and as of this date have failed to abate the nuisance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA:

The main structure on the real estate legally described as Lots 8 and 9 (except the South 60 feet of Lot 9) in Block 1 in OAKLAND HEIGHTS, an Official Plat, now included in and forming a part of the City of Des Moines, Polk County, Iowa, and locally known as 1106 Oak Park Avenue, has previously been declared a public nuisance;

The City Legal Department is hereby authorized to file an action in district court to obtain a decree ordering the abatement of the public nuisance, and should the owner(s) fail to abate the nuisance, as ordered, that the matter may be referred to the Department of Engineering which will take all necessary action to demolish and remove said structure.
