WHEREAS, the Police has requested the Finance Department's Procurement Division issue a purchase order for the purchase of standard emergency response equipment including top of the vehicle light bars, sirens, prisoner barrier, prisoner seats, aluminum push bumpers and gunracks to outfit 21 new Police Interceptor vehicles from Kelttek Inc. (205 High Street, Baxter, IA Kelly Milligan, President); and

WHEREAS, the equipment, has been procured through the competitive bid process using the State of Iowa Master Agreement 55090-15; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Code section 2-726 (k) provides for the procurement of goods and/or services from contracts established by the State of Iowa Department of Administrative Services, the Iowa Department of Transportation, or the Iowa Communications Network pursuant to procedures established by Iowa Code Chapter 8A and rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, without conforming to the competitive bidding requirements of the Procurement Division; and

WHEREAS, funding in the amount of \$176,156.59 for the purchase of emergency response equipment is available from Operating Budget (PD001351) for Police Planning and Budget; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council accepts and approves the purchase and replacement of the emergency response equipment from Kelttek Inc. (205 High Street, Baxter, IA, Kelly Milligan, President), for a total amount of \$176,156.59.
