APPROVING CITY COUNCIL INITIATION OF VACATION OF SOUTHEAST 14<sup>TH</sup> COURT RIGHT-OF-WAY IN THE VICINITY OF 97 JOHNSON COURT

WHEREAS, the owners of the residential property known as Polk County Parcel No. 040/03798-000-000, east of and adjoining 97 Johnson Court, are pursuing vacation and conveyance of the City-owned north/south Southeast 14<sup>th</sup> Court right-of-way immediately south of East Vine Street and adjoining said Parcel; and

WHEREAS, City policy requires that an application to privately initiate the vacation of a public right-of-way must be accompanied by the written consent of the owners of all property adjoining the right-of-way proposed to be vacated; and

WHEREAS, the owners of the residential property known as Polk County Parcel No. 040/03798-000-000, east of and adjoining 97 Johnson Court, have failed to obtain the consent to the vacation of the right-of-way from all adjoining property owners; and

WHEREAS, the owners of said Parcel have requested that the City Council initiate the process to consider the vacation of this right-of-way.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the vacation of the City-owned north/south Southeast 14<sup>th</sup> Court right-of-way immediately south of East Vine Street, is hereby referred to the Plan and Zoning Commission and City staff for review and recommendation to the City Council.
