APPROVAL OF EXTENSION OPTION OF MUNICIPAL PARKING FACILITIES MANAGEMENT SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH ABM PARKING SERVICES, INC.

WHEREAS, on September 23, 2013, by Roll Call No. 13-1492, the City Council approved an agreement with ABM Parking Services, Inc., for management services for the Municipal Parking Facilities for an initial term of three years and nine months, with an option to extend the contract for four additional one-year periods; and

WHEREAS, on June 24, 2019, by Roll Call No. 19-1004, the City Council approved the third one-year option term of the agreement which will expire on June 30, 2020, and it is in the City's best interest to extend the agreement with ABM Parking Services, Inc., for the fourth one-year option period extending from July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2021; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the municipal parking facilities management services agreement with ABM Parking Services, Inc., is hereby extended for the fourth one-year option period from July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2021, with the management fee adjusted in accordance with the terms of the agreement and the City Traffic Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to deliver written notice of the City's exercise of the fourth option to extend to ABM Parking Services, Inc.
