WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department has requested the Finance Department's Procurement Division issue a purchase order for the purchase of playground equipment for Weeks Middle School Park; and

WHEREAS, the equipment, is being procured through the competitive bid process using National Cooperative Purchasing Alliance (NCPA), Contract Number 10-03; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Code section 2-726(m) authorizes the procurement of goods and/or services from contracts that have been competitively established through cooperative group contracting consortiums for state government departments, institutions, agencies and political subdivisions, without conforming to the competitive bidding requirements of the Procurement Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the playground equipment is being purchased from Landscape Structures of Deleno Minnesota, Steve King (Founder, Chairman of the Board), 601 7th Street South Delano, MN 55328, at a total cost of \$67,580; and

WHEREAS, funding is available from 2020-21 CIP, Page Park - TBD, Weeks Middle School Park, PK188, Being: \$67,580 in G.O. Bonds issued.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, accepts and approves the purchase of playground equipment for Weeks Middle School Park from Landscape Structures, in the amount of \$67,580 using the National Cooperative Purchasing Alliance (NCPA), Contract Number 10-03.
